

# Emergency Evacuation Policy

---

Fire escapes are;

1. Kitchen back door
2. Conservatory back door
3. Front door
4. Garage door

If escaping to the back of the house, we will leave the garden [if safe to do so] via next doors gate into their garden and through to the front of the house and over the road.

If we are already at the front then we will stay over the road or wherever is safe. Parents would be notified as soon as possible and any injury would be assessed and dealt with by myself, paramedic/fireman or responsible adult.

I have access to a fire blanket. Smoke alarms are tested regularly. Fire drills are practised and recorded.

Emergency Back-up plan if an emergency occurred and I was unable to look after your child

I would leave your child with an Ofsted registered childminder or a responsible adult. Myself or the responsible adult/childminder would contact you as soon as possible to let you know where your child is. I can arrange/provide meetings if you prefer.
